What is PGCM - Public Accounting program?

PGCM – Public Accounting aims to improve subject-related analytical skills of the candidate that enhance their decision-making and interpersonal skills in the relevant field, it prepares students for successful careers in public accounting, industry, government, and related fields.

All India Management Association's Post Graduate Certificate Programme (PGCM) in Management (approved by AICTE, Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India) is for working professionals and fresh graduates who want to enhance their knowledge base and stay industry relevant.

What is the qualification required for admission?

- Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or 3 years' diploma after 10+2 (equivalent to graduation in any discipline) from an institution, recognized by AICTE.
- Graduate students pursuing other professional courses like MBA, MFS, CPA, CA, CS, ICWA etc.

How many credits are offered under this program?

There would be 8 papers and a project work, each of the subject/paper is of 4 credit and project work would be of 8 credits. The program will be of total 40 credits.

For whom this program is relevant?

- Fresh graduates/Final year students seeking a career in Public Accounting.
- Students pursuing CPA exam.
- Professionals looking to develop their skills in Public Accounting and to learn international accounting standards.
- Professionals who want to explore career opportunities in Finance and related field.

What is the application fee?

The programme fee is INR 25000 + admission fee is INR 1000, a total of INR 26000

What is the duration of the program?

The duration of the programme is 1 year with two semesters. Maximum duration to complete the programme is 3 years.

When would the exams be conducted?

Exams are held in June and December each year. Exam schedule is updated on AIMA website and Student Portal both.
